HAYYA ALAS-SALAAT (COME TO WORSHIP)

Salat begins with the Adhan, followed by the Iqamat:

Allahu Akbar, Allahu Akbar Ash-hadu an la ilaha illa 'llah Ash-hadu anna Muhammadar Rasoolullah, Hayya ala-s-salat Hayya alal falah Qad iqamatis salat Allahu Akbar, Allahu Akbar La ilaha illa 'llah





We then say (silently) our intention for salat:

Na-wai - to an oosal-le salaat _____ lillahi ta 'aala (I intend to perform _____ (mention name of prayer) to Allah, the Most high)

Raise hands to the shoulders, with your palms facing the Qibla, your fingers straight up and your thumbs touching your earlobes and say: **Allahu Akbar.** This is called "takbirat-al-ihram." The open palms signify our empty-hands before Allah.

Standing erect with folded arms, left wrist over the navel, and right hand over left wrist, 1

say "soob-haa-nakal-lahum-ma wa be-hamdika wa tabara-kasmuka wa ta-aala jad-duka wa laa ilaha ghai-ruka

'Aoozu bil-lahe minash-shai-taanir-rajeem²



And now recite Surat-ul-Faatihah (The Chapter of

The Opening): Bismillahir Rahmaanir Rahim



Alhamdu lillahi Rabbil aalameen. Ar-Rahmanir Rahim. Maliki yawmid-din. Iyyaka na'budu.

Wa iyyaka nasta 'een. Ih-dinas-siratal mustaqeem. Siratal-ladzeena an amta alaihim, ghairil maghdoobi alaihim, waladdaaleen.

Followed by another surah, for example:

Bismillahir Rahmanir Rahim

²Glory to Thee, O Allah, and Thine is the Praise, blessed is Thy name, and exalted is Thy Majesty, and there is none to be served besides Thee. I seek refuge in Allah against the accursed Satan.

¹The woman should place both palms in the same manner but on top of the breasts.

Qul huwa-llahu Ahad. Allahus Samad. Lam yalid, walam you lad. Walam yakun lahu, kufwan Ahad.

With the words **Allahu Akbar** go to the bowing position (**Ruku'u**). Let your knees be firmly held in your palms, and your bent back leveled with your head. Relax, and say the following:

soob hana Rabbi yal 'azeem (three times) Glory be to Thee, my Lord, the Mighty







Then say: **sami'a- 'llahu liman hamida hu,** (Allah hears the one who praises Him), as you rise from the bowing position.

While standing erect, say: **Rab-bana lakal hamdu**(Our Lord, praise belongs to You).

With the words **Allahu Akbar**, now go down to the prostrate *(sajdah)* position. In this position, lay your palms face down with your fingers stretched toward the

Qibla, your knees should be on the ground, and the tip of the toes of your feet face the Qibla, place your face between your palms making sure that your forehead is on the ground. It is very important that your forehead, your palms, your knees, and your toes touch the ground while in this position. While in sajdah, say:

Soob- hana Rab-bi yal- a'alaa (three times) Glory be to Thee, My Lord, the Most High







Rise up from sajdah with the words Allahu Akbar, sit down

briefly, and say: Rab-bi igh-firlee wa-r-ham-nee (my Lord, forgive me and have mercy on me).

Say Allahu Akbar again and repeat the sajdah.



Repeat: Soob-hana rab-biyal a'alaa (3 times)

THIS SECOND SAJDAH MARKS THE END OF ONE RAKA'AH.

With the words **Allahu Akbar**, Rise up to the standing position and repeat the entire process from al-Faatihah. This stage begins the second raka'ah.

After the second prostration, sit down. Place the left hand on your left knee, and your right hand on your right knee, and recite the following:

At-tahiyaatu lillahi was-salawaatu wa tayyi baatu



(All salutations and prayers are for Allah)

As-salaamu alaika ayyu-han-nabiyyu

(Peace be unto you, O Prophet)

Wa rah'matullahi wa barakatuhu

(And the Mercy and Blessings of Allah)

Assalaamu alaina (Peace be unto us)

wa ala ibaada-llahis-saaliheen

(and unto all the righteous servants of Allah)



Now raise the index finger of the right hand, and say the Tashahhud, which is:

Ash hadu an laa ilaaha illaa-llah I bear witness that there is no god but Allah

wa ash hadu anna Muhammadan and I bear witness that Muhammad is

abduhu wa rasoo-luhu His servant and His messenger

If this is the final sitting³, then say the following prayers to end the salaat:

Allahumma salli ala Muhammad (O Allah! Bless Muhammad)

wa alaa aali Muhammad (And the true followers of Muhammad)

kama salaita ala Ibraaheem (As you Blessed Abraham)

wa ala aali Ibraaheem (And the true followers of Abraham)

wa baarik alaa Muhammad (And bless Muhammad)

wa ala aali Muhammad (And the true followers of Muhammad)




wa alaa aali Ibraaheem (And the true followers of Abraham)

fil aalameen innaka (For certainly in the universe, You are)

hameedoon majeed (The Owner of praise and splendor.)

To end the salat turn your head to the right and say the tasleem:

³Final sitting refers to the last sitting before saying tasleem to end your prayer.



Assalaamu alaikum wa rah'ma-tul-lah



then to the left and repeat:

Assalaamu alaikum wa rah'matullah.

The following prayers are recommended after the *tasleem*:

Allahumma antas-Salaam O Allah, You are Peace

Wa minka-s-Salaam And Peace comes from You

tabarakta ya dzal jalali wal ikram Blessed are You, the Possessor of Majesty and Honor

Ayat-al-Kursiyyi (Verses of the Throne)

Allahu la ilaha illa Huwa Allah, there is no god beside Him

Al Hayyul Qayyoom The Ever-Living, the Self-Subsisting by Whom all subsists

La ta'khudzuhu sinatun wa la nawm Slumber does not overtake Him, nor sleep

lahu ma fis-samawati wa ma fil ardi Whatever is in the heavens nor in the earth is His

man dzal-ladzee yashfa'ou indahu Who is he that can intercede with Him

illa bi idz-nihe Except by His permission

Ya'lamu ma baina aideehim He knows what is before them

Wa ma khalfa hum

And what is behind them

Wa la yuhee toona be shay-im

And they cannot comprehend anything

Min ilmihee illa be ma shaa'a out of His knowledge except what He pleases

Wasi 'a kur-siyu-hus-sama-wati wal ardi His throne extends over the heavens and the earth

Wa la yahud-duhu hifzu-huma

And the preservation of them tires Him not

Wa huwal Aliyyul Azeem And He is the Most High, the Great.

Note: There are other prayers that could be said before the end of the prayer, but they are optional. What we have sought to do in this little presentation is the very basics of salaat.

If the particular prayer involves four raka'ahs, for example: **Zuhur, Asr, or Isha,** or even three raka'ah as in the case of **Maghrib,** don't say any additional surah after al-Faatihah in the third and fourth raka'ah. The Faatihah in all of these raka'ahs are said silently.

Finally, the two afternoon prayers: Zuhur and Asr are performed silently, except in the case of the Jum'ah (Friday congregational prayer).
